Safe Range Handling Requirements

Range Rules

- 1. Handguns and magazines/speed-loaders brought to and removed from a Lady Hawks event venue must be completely unloaded and contained in a soft or hard gun case or a holster with retention strap or other device.
- 2. Do not handle or take the cased handgun from your vehicle until advised to do so by the lead instructor.
- 3. Keep the handgun cased at all times until advised by an instructor.
- 4. No firearms or live ammunition in the classroom.
- 5. Handguns brought to and from the firing line must be unloaded and cased.
- 6. Do not move to or depart from the firing line with the handgun in your hand.
- 7. No handgun shall be left unattended.
- 8. When not actually being fired, a handgun must be unloaded and:
 - a. Holstered or cased (at the direction of the instructor), OR
 - b. Benched, muzzle pointing down-range (at the targets) and action open.

9. Remember:

- a. DOWN-RANGE *means* In front of the firing line. Toward the targets and in front of the gun.
- b. UP-RANGE *means* Behind the firing line. To the rear of the firing line. Behind the gun.
